HOMEWORK

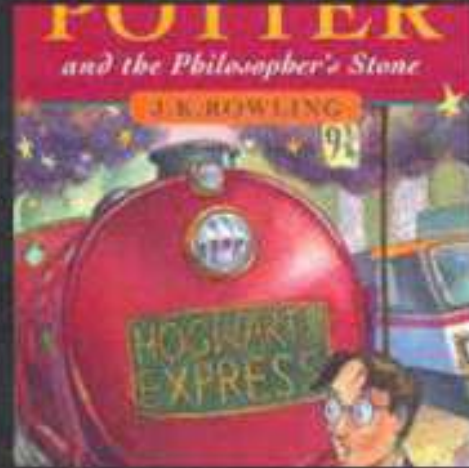
The children will be given pieces of homework each week, on a Friday which is to be returned on Thursday.

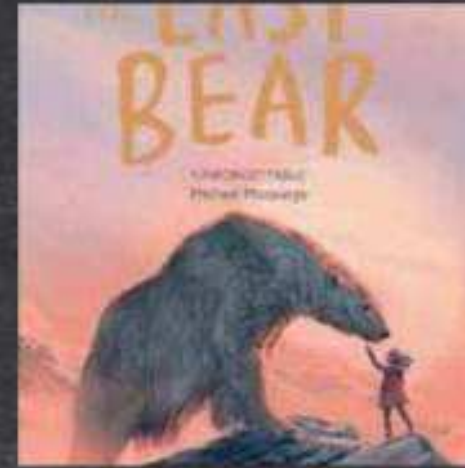

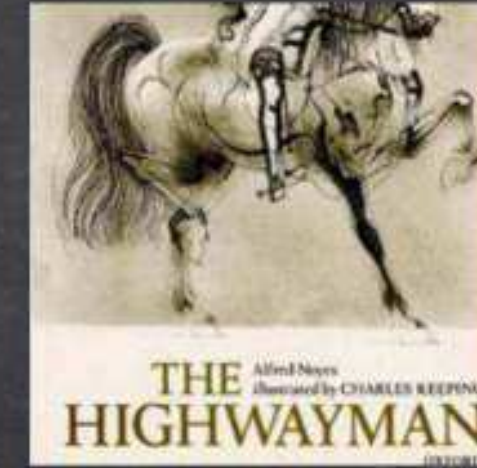

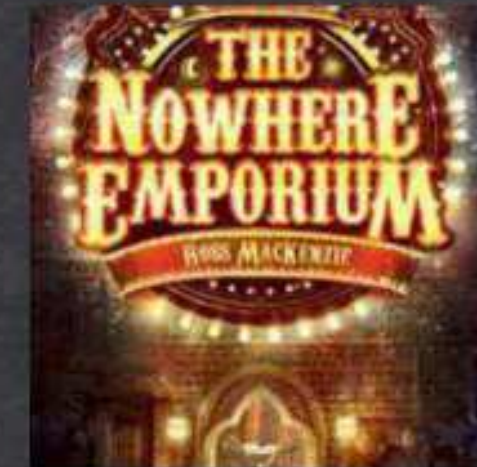
